**Administrative Specialist** Performs a variety of routine and complex administrative and technical work to provide efficient and effective permitting, program and grant management in the administration of the City's Environmental Stewardship Department, Conservation Commission and Zoning Board of Appeals.

**Building Inspector** Performs a variety of routine and complex technical work in building inspection work plan review and zoning enforcement to insure that the Massachusetts Building Code and other related codes and standards are met.

**Commissioner of Buildings and Inspectional Services** Performs a variety of routine and complex administrative, supervisory and technical work in administering and enforcing building and related codes. The Commissioner will supervise all aspects of the Department of Inspectional Services.

**Coordinator, Anti-Gang Program** Coordinates, guides, oversees, assists, and evaluates community goals and strategies to reduce youth gang activity. Promotes community capacity-building to sustain the anti-gang efforts beyond the funding period and to address social and economic issues that contribute to the city's youth gang problem.

**Deputy Inspector of Buildings** Performs a variety of routine and complex administrative, supervisory and technical work in administering and enforcing building and related codes.

**Electrician** Installs, repairs, replaces, upgrades, tests, and maintains electrical equipment and wiring in city-owned buildings or properties. This may include power, lighting, traffic control systems, fire alarm systems, water and/or wastewater treatment plant equipment.

**Librarian II** Plans and administers public library service according to New Bedford Free Public Library policies and procedures.

**Paramedic (Intermittent)** Provides advanced emergency care to the sick and injured. Complies with all policies, practices, and procedures of the EMS Department and the City of New Bedford.

**Purchasing Agent** Responsible as the Chief Procurement Officer of all supplies, services, materials and equipment for all departments and offices of the City pursuant to the provisions of General Laws Chapter 30B. The Purchasing Agent shall be responsible for the maintenance of all files and records required to be kept by law and make such records available for public inspection. Responsible for contract compliance.

**Special Motor Equipment Operator (Temporary)** Operates City-owned equipment, which requires possession of a Hoisting License.
